Subject: Trade licensing of Fluid Power Industry practitioners

I request that the Government of Western Australia enact legislation to establish the statutory requirement for the work that is normally carried out by particular categories of occupations in the field of *Fluid Power Engineering*, to only be carried out by persons in possession of appropriate qualifications that are recognised by the issuing of a license in a similar way to that currently applying to, for example, electrical, plumbing and gas fitting work in Western Australia.

I strongly support any submission which *Fluid Power Society (WA) Inc.* makes to the Government of Western Australia, that *Fluid Power Technicians* and *Fitters* and also *High Pressure Hose Assemblers* should be licensed, as mentioned in the preceding paragraph, to legally carry out the normal work of those occupations in the fluid power industry.
